The following regulations made under the Data Protection Act 1998 came into effect on the 1st March 2000:

31 Jan 2000	SI 2000/183 (C4)	The Data Protection Act 1998 (Commencement) Order 2000	Brings the Act (other than section 56 and those provisions already in force by virtue of section 75 (2)) into force on 1st March 2000.
31 Jan 2000	SI 2000/191	The Data Protection (Subject Access) (Fees and Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 2000	Miscellaneous provisions in respect of the subject access right.
31 Jan 2000	SI 2000/187	The Data Protection (Fees under section 19(7)) Regulations 2000	Sets a fee of £2 for a certified copy of a data controller's entry on the register.
17 Feb 2000	SI 2000/417	The Data Protection (Processing of Sensitive Personal Data) Order 2000	Establishes conditions for processing sensitive personal data in accordance with the first data protection principle
31 Jan 2000	SI 2000/185	The Data Protection (Conditions under Paragraph 3 of Part II of Schedule 1) Order 2000	Provides information about data processing to data subjects (" the information requirements ").
17 Feb 2000	SI 2000/413	The Data Protection (Subject Access Modification) (Health) Order 2000	Partially excludes mental health records from subject access
17 Feb 2000	SI 2000/414	The Data Protection (Subject Access Modification) (Education) Order 2000	Partially excludes educational records from subject access
17 Feb 2000	SI 2000/415	The Data Protection (Subject Access Modification) (Social Work) Order 2000	Partially excludes social work from subject access where there is a danger that access might cause serious harm to the physical or mental health or condition of the data subject or another person
17 Feb 2000	SI 2000/419	The Data Protection (Miscellaneous Subject Access Exemptions) Order 2000	Excludes human fertilization and embryology information and adoption records from subject access.

31 Jan 2000	SI 2000/184	The Data Protection (Corporate Finance Exemption) Order 2000	Provides criteria for determining whether exemption from the subject information provisions is required to safeguard important UK economic or financial interests.
17 Feb 2000	SI 2000/416	The Data Protection (Crown Appointments) Order 2000	Exempts from the subject information provisions processing of personal data for assessing a person's suitability for certain Crown appointments.
17 Feb 2000	SI 2000/418	The Data Protection (Designated Codes of Practice) Order 2000	Designates certain codes of practice issued by various broadcasting and other media organizations.
31 Jan 2000	SI 2000/189	The Data Protection Tribunal (Enforcement Appeals) Rules 2000	Rules of procedure for the Data Protection Tribunal in enforcement appeals
2 Feb 2000	SI 2000/206	The Data Protection Tribunal (National Security Appeals) Rules 2000	Rules of Procedure for the Data Protection Tribunal in national security appeals
31 Jan 2000	SI 2000/190	The Data Protection (International Co-operation) Order 2000	Provides for co-operation between the Commissioner, the European Commission and supervisory authorities in other EEA States
31 Jan 2000	SI 2000/186	The Data Protection (Functions of Designated Authority) Order 2000	Designates the Commissioner as the "designated authority" in the United Kingdom for the purposes of article 13 of the Council of Europe Data Protection Convention.

Also brought into force are

- the Telecommunications (Data Protection and Privacy) (Amendment) Regulations 2000 (SI 2000 No 157) made on the 25th March 2000 which came into force on the 1st March 2000; and
- the Data Protection Tribunal (National Security Appeals) (Telecommunications) Rules 2000 (SI 2000 No 731) made on the 9th March 2000 which came into force on the 5th April 2000
